The Company has made a request for a redemption of the Units on 19th May 2020 which has not been satisfied as yet by the Fund Manager of the Unit Trust.

- Accounting policies and methods of computation adopted in the above interim accounts are same as those in the previous Audited Financial Statements and also in compliance with Sri Lanka Accounting Standard 34 - Interim Financial Reporting.
- 2) The above figures are provisional and subject to audit.
- 3) There have been no events subsequent to the interim period, which require disclosure in the interim financial statements.
- 4) There has not been a significant change in the nature of contingent liabilities which were disclosed in the Annual Report for the year ended 31st March 2019
- 5) Starting mid of March 20, the crop intake and the production as well drastically declined with the outbreak of COVID-19, mainly due to restrictions on working days and social distancing as well. However normal operations resumed under essential service being declared by the Government. Plantation sector realigned well during the month of April 2020 at the Estate operational level, but the Head Office got disrupted due to the enforcement of curfew in Colombo which had an impact on maintaining accounting records during the months of March/April 2020. Whilst the production of Tea improved during the latter part of April 2020 and in May 2020 and the prices too showed commensurate increases, the Plantation sector as a whole were afraid of the risk involved in the disruption of the exports in the global supply chain.
